FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAM

The Tiffin Community YMCA offers programs and services designed to benefit people of all incomes, ages, gender and backgrounds. It is our pledge, within the available resources of the YMCA, to provide services to individuals regardless of the ability to pay. All records are kept confidential. Assistance may be available toward memberships and programs.

HOW TO APPLY

1. Application must be **COMPLETELY** filled out before a determination can be made.
2. Turn in or mail application and **financial verification** to the YMCA. (Applications presented without financial verification will not be processed)

ELIGIBILITY

1. Applicants must be a resident or work in the Y service area
2. Applicants will normally be asked to pay a portion of the fee.
3. Government Assistance: Notice of Decision (with names of eligible person(s) and total income including food stamps).
4. Social Security Disability: Letter from Social Security office of Notice of Decision stating the monthly benefit amount.
5. Unemployed: Notification of eligible benefits from unemployment office. Federal tax return will still be needed, as unemployment is taxable income.
6. **No Income: Please submit the income of the person(s) supporting the applicant.**
7. Last years tax return **required.** (if income is different from previous years submit a letter stating why income has changed).
8. **All individuals requesting membership assistance MUST LIVE IN THE SAME HOUSEHOLD.**

DETERMINATION

A determination letter will be sent to the address on the application. Payment is required by the expiration date included in the letter. This is a 6 month commitment.
